



Three-year undergraduate programme in

Political Sciences (SPO)

The course has been thoroughly revised, though still maintaining its multidisciplinary character. The first two years include modules in contemporary history, economics, law, political science, and sociology. Courses are offered in both Italian and in English. At the beginning of the last term of the second year, students move from generalist courses to one of five more specialised options (one entirely taught in English). Overall, the multidisciplinary character of the course and the wide number of labs aim at providing students with a flexible approach and cross-cutting understanding of key national and supranational institutions and processes that characterise contemporary societies.

Career and employment

Graduates in Political Sciences will be ready to undertake a wide array of career paths in several sectors, including:

- National and international private companies and organizations;
- Public administration at the national, supranational and international level;
- Third sector organizations and NGOs;
- Research centres;
- Consultancy companies;
- Journalism and publishing.

Thanks to the multidisciplinary nature of the programme, graduates in Political Sciences will also be able to enroll in a large number of postgraduate programmes.
